BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE

- (1) The appellant has filed an application dated 11-12-2013 (Annexure 1) under Section 6 of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting for the following information:
 - (A) Please provide name and designation of the officials of CESTAT (at New Delhi and all other regional centres) who are using Beckon light (red light) and the vehicles used by them. Also provide the rules & regulations or Notifications under which such use is permissible to them.
 - (B) Please provide Vehicle Numbers on which the Beckon light is being used by the CESTAT at New Delhi and other Regional Centres
 - (C) Please provide copy of any authority letter or communication received from any public authority or from the Traffic Police of the concerned station.
 - (D) Please provide copies of all note sheets and correspondence pages of the RTI file in which this application is dealt with, till the date of providing the information
- (2) That the appellant vide para 5 of his said application has also made a declaration that the information sought for is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 of the RTI Act, 2005 and also stated that to the best of the knowledge of the appellant, the information pertains to the Office of the CPIO in question.
- (3) The CPIO vide its impugned order dated 16.12.2013 has provided incomplete and incorrect information The appellant being aggrieved by the said order of the CPIO is filing the present appeal.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL

- (1) That the order in question of the learned CPIO is incorrect and illegal and contrary to the provisions and sprit of the RTI Act, 2005 hence liable to be set aside.
- (2) That the information sought by the appellant is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 or any other provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 and therefore, there was no valid cause or reason or ground for not providing the information.



- (3) That the CPIO has not provided any information in relation to the use of beacon light on CESTAT vehicles at regional centers of CESTAT though specifically sought by the Appellant in Point (A) of the RTI Application. The CPIO has also provided incorrect information inasmuch as the copy of the notification dated 18.02.2003 does not cover the President of the CESTAT. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (4) That the CPIO has not provided any information in relation to the vehicles on which beacon light is used at regional centers of CESTAT though specifically sought by the Appellant in Point (B) of the RTI Application. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (5) That the CPIO has only given the copy of the communication received from the Transport Department of Delhi Government but not the copy of the letter sent by the CESTAT and copy of the note sheets. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (6) That the CPIO has erred in not providing the copy of the Authority Letter as sought by the Appellant in Point (C) of the RTI Application. He has merely enclosed a Letter dated 09.06.2011of the transport department which does not authorize the use of the beacon light by CESTAT President. CPIO has not provided copy of the letter sent by CESTAT to the Transport department nor subsequent correspondences. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (7) That the Ld. CPIO has erred in not providing the information to the appellant though as per the provisions of the RTI Act, the appellant is entitled to information as sought by him. Therefore, the order of the CPIO

is liable to be set aside with direction to provide the information to the appellant within time bound frame.

- (8) That as per proviso to Section 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, the information which can not be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures shall not be denied to any person. The information sought by the appellant in the subject application is the one which cannot be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures and hence it cannot be denied or refused to the appellant.
- (9) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the present appeal.
- (10) This is without prejudice to the right of the appellant to add, alter or modify any of the grounds of this appeal and adduce oral or written evidence at the time of hearing or till the appeal is disposed of.

PRAYER

Under the circumstances, the appellant prays as under:

- (a) That the Original Records may be summoned and perused.
- (b) That the order of the CPIO may be set aside and he may be directed to provide the information in question within time bound frame.
- (c) That any other relief as the Appellate Authority deem fit and proper may also be ordered in favour of the appellant.
- (d) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the appeal.





BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE

- (1) The appellant has filed an application dated 04-10-2013 (Annexure 1) under Section 6 of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting for the following information:
 - (A) Please provide list of all appeals and applications (including stay applications) pending as on 1-10-2013 or any other date of October, as is convenient to you, for all Benches at New Delhi indicating the name of parties, appeal/application No., date of filing, amount of duty, penalty, fine and interest involved and name of the Advocate/Consultant, if available. The information may be provided on CD for which a Postal Order No. 79G 009413 for Rs. 50/- is enclosed.
 - (B) Please provide list of cases heard by all Benches at New Delhi in which orders have been reserved but not pronounced within 90 days of last hearing as on 1-10-2013
 - (C) Please provide list of cases in which the operative part of the order has been pronounced during hearing, but the written order has not been issued within 90 days of said hearing as on 1-10-2013.
- (2) That the appellant vide para 5 of his said application has also made a declaration that the information sought for is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 of the RTI Act, 2005 and also stated that to the best of the knowledge of the appellant, the information pertains to the Office of the CPIO in question.
- (3) That the CPIO by his order dated 10-10-2013 (Annexure-2) forwarded the application to 4 Deemed CPIOs. The CPIO by his letter dated 14-10-2013 (Annexure-3) provided incomplete and incorrect information. The appellant filed a first appeal dated 17-10-2013 (Annexure-4) which was heard on 31-10-2013 and was dismissed as premature. The appellant further received letter dated 23-10-2013 (Annexure-5) providing

incomplete and incorrect information. The First Appellate Authority by order dated 31-10-2013 (Annexure-7) had dismissed the aforesaid appeal as pre-mature. The CPIO lastly by letter dated 25-10-2013 (Annexure-6) provided incomplete information. The appellant being aggrieved by the said orders of the CPIO is filing the present appeal.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL

- (1) That the order in question of the learned CPIO is incorrect and illegal and contrary to the provisions and sprit of the RTI Act, 2005 hence liable to be set aside.
- (2) That the information sought by the appellant is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 or any other provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 and therefore, there was no valid cause or reason or ground for not providing the information.
- (3) That the Deemed CPIO of the Single Member Bench has not so far provided any information inspite of the RTI application in question having been transferred to him. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (4) That the CPIO and the deemed CPIOs has erred in providing incomplete information in relation to point (A) of the RTI application, inasmuch as he has provided only the data pending appeals from 4 January 2012, whereas the appellant has sought the information of all the pending appeals and applications as on 1 October 2013 or for any other date of October 2013 with the particulars specified in the said application. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (5) That the CPIO and the deemed CPIO of the Customs Branch and the Central Excise Branch have failed to provide information sought in point (C) of the RTI application. As per the provisions of the RTI Act, they should have forwarded / transferred the RTI application to the Officers, who are holding the information. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is

(ij)

incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.

(6) That Deemed CPIO of the Excise Branch has erred in denying the information sought at point (C) of the RTI application on the ground that it is not being maintained. The information in question has wrongly been denied claiming that "not maintained by Excise Branch". Under the RTI Act, the maintenance of information is not the pre-requisite for providing the information. Since the information sought is held by the public authority, it is to be provided. Recently the First Appellate Authority of the CIC in the case of S.C. Agarwal V/s. CIC – First appeal No. CIC/AA/A/2013/269 decided on 3-10-2013 basing its decision on Supreme Court judgment held as under: -

"...Under Section 2(j), the Right to Information conferred on the citizen means Right to Information "accessible" under the Act, which is "held by" or is "under the control of" any Public Authority. The attention of the CPIO is also drawn to judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Secretary General, Supreme Court of India Vs. the petitioner in LPA No. 501/2009, wherein the court has defined the words "held by" and "under the control of" as under:-

"The words 'held by' or 'under the control of' under Section 2(j) will include not only information under the legal control of the public authority but also all such information which is otherwise received or used or consciously retained by the public authority in the course of its functions and its official capacity." (emphasis supplied)

The information sought for by the appellant squarely falls within the ambit of the information of as defined under the RTI Act, there is no denying that it is within the mischief of section 2 (j) of the RTI Act. In view of this, and the reliance placed on the judgment of the Commission dated 23.05.2013 in the case of R.K. Jain Vs. CIC, the replies given in response to the four queries namely 4, 5, 7 and 8 by the nodal CPIO is set-aside and he is directed to obtain the



information from the concerned registries or provide access to the information seeker to peruse the records and get the required information. The CPIO is free to proceed in terms of the provisions of the RTI Act while replying again to these queries."

In view of the above decision of the First Appellate Authority of the CIC, CPIO and Deemed CPIOs are required to provide the information as sought in point © of the RTI application. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.

- (7) That the Ld. CPIO has erred in not providing the information to the appellant though as per the provisions of the RTI Act, the appellant is entitled to information as sought by him. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is liable to be set aside with direction to provide the information to the appellant within time bound frame.
- (8) That the Ld. CPIO has erred in not providing the information to the appellant though as per the provisions of the RTI Act, the appellant is entitled to information as sought by him. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is liable to be set aside with direction to provide the information to the appellant within time bound frame.
- (9) That the information sought is neither voluminous nor relate to older and larger period, thus could have easily been provided by the learned CPIO.
- (10) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the present appeal.
- (11) This is without prejudice to the right of the appellant to add, alter or modify any of the grounds of this appeal and adduce oral or written evidence at the time of hearing or till the appeal is disposed of.



BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE

- (1) The appellant has filed an application dated 13-09-2013 (Annexure 1) under Section 6 of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting for the following information:
 - (A) Please provide the copy of the comments made by the then CPIO Shri S.K. Verma in terms of CIC Order in case No. CIC/SS/C/2012/000362 dated 17-5-2013 (copy enclosed)
 - (B) Please provide date-wise details of the action taken on my letter No. RTI/P-195/3622/11/R6171 dated 23-5-2013 (copy enclosed).
 - (C) Please provide the date-wise details of the action taken by CESTAT for non-compliance of the CIC order.
- (2) That the appellant vide para 5 of his said application has also made a declaration that the information sought for is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 of the RTI Act, 2005 and also stated that to the best of the knowledge of the appellant, the information pertains to the Office of the CPIO in question.
- (3) That the appellant received letter dated 16-9-2013 (Annexure-2) of the CPIO to Registrar, CESTAT. The Appellant vide letter dated 20-9-2013.(Annexure-5) requested the said authority to provide the desired information within the period of 30 days as stipulated under Section 7(1) of the RTI Act, 2005. The Appellant has neither received any information nor any response from the said authority therefore, as per Section 7(2) of the RTI Act, 2005, the request for information shall be deemed to have been refused. Thus being aggrieved by such refusal, this Appeal.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL

- (1) That the action of the learned CPIO and the deemed CPIO in not providing the information to the appellant is illegal and contrary to the provisions and sprit of the RTI Act, 2005.
- (2) That the information sought by the appellant is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 or any other provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 and therefore,

- there was no valid cause or reason or ground for not providing the information.
- (3) That the inaction of the learned CPIO is in violation of Sections 7(1) and 7(2) of the RTI Act, 2005 and is therefore, illegal. Such inaction is deemed to be a refusal to the request of the appellant without any reasonable cause or ground hence is illegal.
- (4) That the information sought is neither voluminous nor relate to older and larger period, thus could have easily been provided by the learned CPIO.
- (5) That the appellant is citizen of India and fulfilled all other requirements of the RTI Act and the Rules made thereunder and is entitled to the information in question.
- (6) That as per proviso to Section 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, the information which can not be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures shall not be denied to any person. The information sought by the appellant in the subject application is the one which cannot be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures and hence it cannot be denied or refused to the appellant.
- (7) This is without prejudice to the right of the appellant to add, alter or modify any of the grounds of this appeal and adduce oral or written evidence at the time of hearing.
- (8) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the present appeal.
- (9) This is without prejudice to the right of the appellant to add, alter or modify any of the grounds of this appeal and adduce oral or written evidence at the time of hearing or till the appeal is disposed of.

PRAYER

Under the circumstances, the appellant prays as under:

(a) That the Original Records may be summoned and perused.

- (b) That the CPIO may be directed to provide the information in question within time bound frame.
- (c) That any other relief as the Appellate Authority deem fit and proper may also be ordered in favour of the appellant.
- (d) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the appeal.

INTERIM ORDER

Shri R.K. Jain, hereinafter called the appellant, has filed the present complaint dated 13.4.2012, before the Commission against the respondent Customs, Excise & Service Tax Appellate Tribunal (CESTAT), New Delhi for not providing information in response to his RTI-application (Ref. No: RTI/11/3622) dated 1.8.2011. The appellant was present, where as the respondent were represented by Shri Naresh Kumar, Dy. Registrar and Shri S.K. Verma, Assistant Registrar.

- 2. The appellant, through his RTI application dated 1.8.2011 sought information on the following two queries: "(A) Please provide inspection of records of following appeals: (i) Appeal No. E/324/2010-EX (Shri Hari Agro Industries V. Commissioner, (ii) Appeal No. E/365/2009-EX (Pan Parag Ltd), (iii) Appeal Nos. E/59-61/2010-EX (Sitalspal), (iv) Appeal No. E/2331/2010-EX (Kennily Honda); (B) Please provide copies of orders, records of proceedings and note-sheets of the above appeals".
- 3: Aggrieved with non receipt of any response from the CPIO, the appellant filed first appeal before the FAA. The FAA vide his order No. 66 of 2011 dated

J-41/65 hazed Flee

8.11.2011 had passed a common order on appellant's 90 RTI applications, held as follows: "that the CRIO has to examine each of the applications and furnish information where available. Where information is not available in the form in which it is asked, the position may be informed to the appellant. If any application is to be rejected for any reason specified in Section 8 or 9 of the RTI Act, the reason has to be specified and orders should be passed independently in respect of each application. The CPIO has to ensure that each order is numbered and dated".

- 4. In his complaint filed before the Commission the appellant states as under:
 - That Shri S.K. Verma, CPIO, CESTAT, New Delhi has deliberately, malafidely and persistently not providing the information inspite of the clear mandate of the RTI Act and direction of the FAA dated 8.11.2011 and repeated reminders of the Complainant, even though the information sought is readily available with him and is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 or any other provisions of the RTI Act. Therefore, the CPIO is liable for penalty u/s 20(1) of the RTI Act and recommendation for disciplinary action u/s 20(2) of the RTI Act, for defying the orders of the FAA and obstructing the information in question, without any reasonable cause.
 - The CPIO has knowingly, malafidely delayed and denied the information in question and even after the FAA vide para 11 of his order dated 8.1.2011 has directed the CPIO to specifically examine each RTI application and furnish information wherever available and where information is not available, the position may be informed to the complainant. Inspite of these directions of the FAA and reminders dated 11.11.2011 and 26.3.2012 of the complainant, neither any information has so far been provided to the complainant nor the RTI application in question has been dealt with.
 - The CPIO delayed and obstructed the information in question till date inspite of the time-bound specific provisions of Section 7 of the RTI Act. The malafide of the CPIO is further evident from the fact that he did not provide information inspite of specific direction dated 8.11.2011 of the FAA and complainant's repeated reminders to him.
 - That FAA's order dated 8.11.2011 has not so far been complied with inspite of repeated reminders of the complainant.
 - That the complainant has been put to inconvenience, harassment and mental agony because of the malafide conduct of the CPIO, therefore, the complainant is entitled to compensation u/s 19(8) of the RTI Act for the loss and other detrimental suffered by the complainant.
- 5. Having considered the submissions of the parties, the Commission hereby directs the CPIO to file his comments before the Commission and endorse a

Case No. CIC/SS/C/2012/000362

copy to the complainant within two weeks of receipt of his order. The complainant is advised to file his counter submissions, if any, within two weeks of receipt of comments from the CPIO. On receipt of comments from the CPIO and counter submissions from the complainant, the matter will be decided in due course.



BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE

- (1) The appellant has filed an application dated 02-09-2013 (Annexure 1) under Section 6 of the RTI Act, 2005 requesting for the following information:
 - (A) Please provide digital data of all pending appeals and applications as on 30-8-2013 with all Benches of the CESTAT indicating appeal / application No., name of parties, date of filing, amount of duty / penalty / interest involved, if any, last date of hearing, if already listed.
 - (B) Please provide list of remand cases pending as on 30-8-2013 with all Benches of the CESTAT indicating appeal / application No., name of parties, date of remand, authority remanding the matter, amount of duty / penalty / interest involved, if any, last date of hearing, if already listed.
 - (C) Please provide list of Larger Bench cases and Difference Opinion matters pending as on 30-8-2013 for all the Benches.
 - (D) Please provide copies of Monthly Statement for institution/disposal and pendency of appeals/applications in the CESTAT, Bench-wise, age-wise and state-wise from July, 2013 till September, 2013.

Note: The above information is required to be voluntarily disclosed by the CESTAT u/s 4 of the RTI Act. The information disclosed on the

CESTAT website is not updated for a number of years. Hence, this application.

- (2) That the appellant vide para 5 of his said application has also made a declaration that the information sought for is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 of the RTI Act, 2005 and also stated that to the best of the knowledge of the appellant, the information pertains to the Office of the CPIO in question.
- (3) That the CPIO by his impugned order dated 1-11-2013 has not complied with the order of the First Appellate Authority and again provided incomplete information. The appellant being aggrieved by the said order of the CPIO is filing the present appeal.

GROUNDS OF APPEAL

- (1) That the order in question of the learned CPIO is incorrect and illegal and contrary to the provisions and sprit of the RTI Act, 2005 hence liable to be set aside.
- (2) That the information sought by the appellant is not exempted under Section 8 or 9 or any other provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 and therefore, there was no valid cause or reason or ground for not providing the information.
- (3) That the CPIO has erred in not providing the digital data for all the pending appeals / applications as on 30-8-2013 despite of the orders of the First Appellate Authority. The CD provided by the CPIO contains the data only for the year 2012 and 2013 while the appellant has sought digital data for all pending appeals / applications as on 31-8-2013. Therefore, the order of the CPIO is incorrect and illegal and liable to be set aside and the CPIO be directed to provide the information in time bound frame.
- (4) That the Ld. CPIO has erred in not providing the information to the appellant though as per the provisions of the RTI Act, the appellant is entitled to information as sought by him. Therefore, the order of the CPIO

- is liable to be set aside with direction to provide the information to the appellant within time bound frame.
- (4) The CPIO has deliberately and malafidely provided incomplete and incorrect information with a view to cause obstruction to the information without any reasonable cause. Hence, he is liable for penal action under section 20 of the RTI Act, but the First Appellate Authority has no powers to take penal action u/s 20 of the RTI Act, hence the appellant reserves his right to file direct complaint to CIC.
- (5) That the information sought is neither voluminous nor relate to older and larger period, thus could have easily been provided by the learned CPIO.
- (6) That the appellant is citizen of India and fulfilled all other requirements of the RTI Act and the Rules made thereunder and is entitled to the information in question.
- (7) That as per proviso to Section 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, the information which can not be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures shall not be denied to any person. The information sought by the appellant in the subject application is the one which cannot be denied to the Parliament or the State Legislatures and hence it cannot be denied or refused to the appellant.
- (8) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the present appeal.
- (9) This is without prejudice to the right of the appellant to add, alter or modify any of the grounds of this appeal and adduce oral or written evidence at the time of hearing or till the appeal is disposed of.

PRAYER

Under the circumstances, the appellant prays as under:

(a) That the Original Records may be summoned and perused.

- (b) That the order of the CPIO may be set aside and he may be directed to provide the information in question within time bound frame.
- (c) That any other relief as the Appellate Authority deem fit and proper may also be ordered in favour of the appellant.
- (d) That a personal hearing may be granted to the appellant before deciding the appeal.
