This appeal has been filed by the Revenue against Order-in-Appeal No. KOL/CUS/PORT/17/09 dated 13/03/2009 passed by the Commissioner of Customs, Central Excise & Service Tax (Appeals).

2. Shri S. K. Naskar, AC (AR) appeared on behalf of the Revenue and reiterated the grounds of appeals.

3. Heard both sides and perused the appeal records.

4. On perusal of records, we find that the amount involved in this case is below the monetary limit of Rs. 10 lakhs. The present case falls under exclusion clause 3(c) of the National Litigation Policy introduced

vide Board's Instruction dated 17.12.2015 which has been deleted vide Instruction F. No. 390/Misc./116/2017-JC dated 04.04.2018. Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed under litigation policy. Cross objection also disposed of.
