Today, when the matter was called, Shri Arnab Chakraborty, Id. Advocate appearing on behalf of the appellant, submits that the Appellant Company was transferred to M/s Manaksia Industries Limited, which was subsequently renamed as M/s BKM Industries Limited by an order of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta under the Companies Act, 1956. Therefore, the appellants have no jurisdiction to contest the above cited appeal. He also produced a letter written to the Resolution Professional appointed in the case of M/s BKM Industries Limited to pursue the matter, if interested before this Tribunal and also intimated to the respondent to proceed with the Resolution Professional for further proceedings in the matter.
